WHAT

The International Summer School (ISS) is an intensive academic course for Italian and foreign undergraduates.

It offers two weeks study programs in an international context. All the lectures are in English and all courses recognize academic credits. The participants who pass the final exams successfully will receive a transcript of record useful for ECTS credits.

WHO

International academic teachers will hold the lectures. Italian and foreign undergraduates can apply. The candidates must have achieved a bachelor's degree in Economics (L-18) or equivalent qualifications.

Candidates are required to have good knowledge of English (B2 level). Italian students can directly access by showing the certificate of the English exam attended during the Bachelor degree.

WHERE

The International Summer School is set on the wonderful campus that opens its doors to new friendships and experiences.

All students can access to the campus facilities: tennis courts and football fields, swimming-pools, libraries, university cafeteria and they can take part to all the leisure activities that enliven the campus during the two weeks.

Each course is restricted to a maximum of **30 participants**.

WHY

The ISS aims to provide a new opportunity of **internationalization at home** for the Italian students by creating a global student community. Graduate students from all around the world are encouraged to apply for.

The students will enrich their perspective through learning experiences. The ISS provides students great opportunities to focus their academic interests by taking advantage and deepen their know-how on important issues.

WHEN

The courses will be on for two weeks, from **4 to 15 July 2016**.

Each course will be scheduled in **5 days for 3 hours per day, for a total of 15 hours**.

The timetable will be planned to allow everyone to attend more than one course in the same week.
